



1st Qtr 2019 First Response Training International Training Update

As members of International Training, you have agreed to review all standards and procedures changes in Training Updates throughout the year. This is required reading for all First Response Training International Members. Preferably, please download the current version of the standards. If you're still using paper manuals, please make any necessary revisions in your Standards and Procedures Manual upon reviewing this update. Current Version is Revision 0519, issued 05/24/19.

First Response Training International Standards and Procedures

Part 1, Page 28, 6.1, line 1, now reads:

Instructor and Instructor Trainers must comply with the "Two Year Renewal/Refresher Policy" detailed in 6.13 in these General Standards.

6.13 Two Year Renewal/Refresher Policy, language changed to:

Biannual Peer Review.

Every Instructor and Instructor Trainer must go through and successfully complete a biannual peer review with an instructor/Instructor Trainer with equal or greater certification(s). The peer review shall consist of the Required Skill Performance and Graduation Requirements of the specific course as outlined in course standards. Upon successful completion, the peer will sign off on the *First Response Training Instructor Registration/Upgrade Form*. The form must then be submitted to the Instructor/Instructor Trainers Regional office or World Headquarters.

Part 3, section 6.5 Student Prerequisites. Two new bullets added for item 3 and item 4:

3. *Proof of certifying at least 10 individuals at provider level, with at least 5 of these certifications being either Adult and Child Emergency Care or Child Emergency Care.*

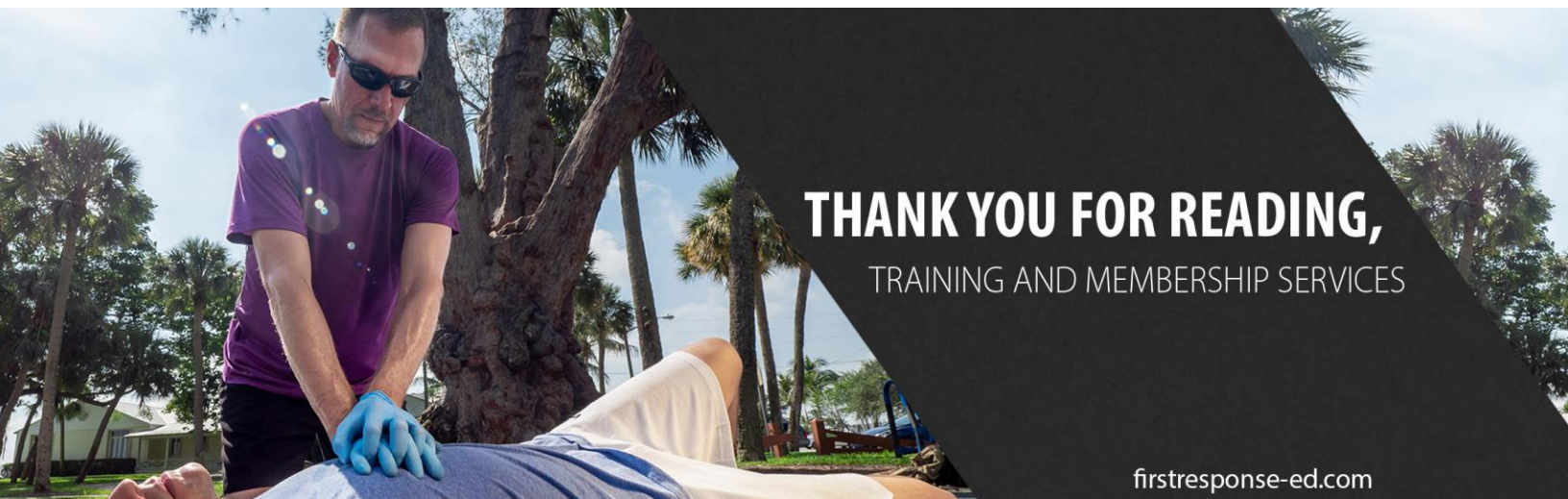
4. *Current International Training Instructor Trainers may apply for an IT upgrade upon meeting item 3 above.*

Part 3, Instructor Course Standards: where final exam is noted, Part 3, sections 1.11, 2.11, 3.11, 4.11, 5.11, under Required Skill Performance and Graduation Requirements, the language now reads:

The Provider level final exam is required with a passing score of 90% or higher. When exam A is administered and a score of 90% or higher is not achieved, provider level final exam B should be administered with a passing score of 90% or higher.

Part 4 – Forms:

Form name changed to current name *International Training Instructor Registration and Upgrade form*:
“Child Emergency Care” & “Workplace CPR/AED” removed from form and language added to clarify that these ratings are automatic when “Adult and Child Emergency Care” registrations are processed.
