2023 First Response Training International Training Update

As members of International Training, you have agreed to review all standards and procedures changes in Training Updates throughout the year. This is required reading for all International Training Members. Please download the current version of the standards. First Response Training International Standards and Procedures

Changes affecting First Response Training International standards for 2023 include:

- Clarified teaching requirement for instructors to maintain active status
- Added suspension/termination for cause clause

Part 1: Introduction

6.3 Active Teaching Status

Item 4, first sentence, replace "at least one course" to "at least one First Response course in the last two years."

6.7 Expelled Status

After existing Note at end of section, add new clause:

Suspension or Termination For Cause - International Training may suspend or terminate membership for Member's commission of any act: (i) involving (A) a felony or (B) repeated use of drugs or intoxicants; or (ii) which disparages the business integrity of International Training, its parent Corporation or subsidiaries or affiliates or their officer directors, employees or customers, and materially and adversely affects the business reputation of International Training.
